# Conduct Agreement <br> Santa Clara University

Santa Clara University's immersion experiences are substance-free. Alcohol and other illegal drugs are not to be transported, purchased, or consumed by anyone involved in any immersion trip, at any time (including travel to and from the immersion community).

This substance-free policy applies to all immersion participants, including those who are 21 years of age and older. The policy also applies to Santa Clara students, staff, and faculty in communities where the legal drinking age may be different from that in the United States. Regardless of age and local custom, alcohol and other illegal drugs are prohibited.

Similarly, participation in Santa Clara University immersion experiences requires full compliance with the University Student Handbook. This includes, but is not limited to, the Statement of Values, the Student Conduct Code, and the relevant Policies and Procedures. For more information about these documents, please refer to the Student Handbook.

Violation of any of the substance-free policy or any of the policies contained in the Student Handbook may result in the student being returned to Santa Clara - with the cost of that transportation the sole responsibility of the student involved - as well as parental notification. As appropriate, staff will report alleged violations of the Student Conduct Code to the Office of Student Life.
