1.	 Time Commitment: I understand and commit to the FULL time commitment that accompanies participation in the immersion outlined below. I agree to my immersion coordinator, promptly if any conflicts arise. a. Spring Break Immersion Kick-Off –(date, time & location TBD). b. Weekly group meetings for 90 minutes starting the week of Feb. 20th – March 19th (4-5 total mtgs.) c. Miscellaneous activities outside of meeting time for 1-2 hours each week. d. The spring break immersion experience. e. At minimum 3 post-trip meetings of 90 minutes occurring in the Spring Quarter.
2.	Cost: I understand that there is a participation fee for the Spring Break Immersion experience. I commit to paying this full amount prior to the trip departure unless otherwise determined by the Ignatian Center staff. I commit to contracting and working with the Ignatian Center staff with regards to any particular financial needs I may have or that may arise during my participation. 4.	Simple Living and Flexibility: I understand that simple living is a pillar of the Ignatian Center immersions and I commit to being flexible and engaging fully in all aspects on the immersion. In this full engagement of simple living, I commit to upholding the Conduct Agreement and representing the values of Santa Clara University throughout the immersion.
